KING OF KINGS

At St Edmund's, we come to the end of this final week of the Liturgical Year by looking back to last Sunday's Gospel from Luke which centred on the feast of Christ the King. The encounter between Jesus and the good thief showed us the power of faith in even the darkest moments, with the thief turning to Jesus and acknowledging Him as the King of Kings.

During this week, children have taken part in prayers and reflections that help them celebrate Jesus as their King and guide. They have been invited to praise Him with confidence, recognise His presence in their daily lives and understand

that through faith we too are called to walk closely with Him. This brings a meaningful close to our year in the Church's calendar.

REQUEST FOR CHRISTMAS TREE LIGHTS AND DECORATIONS


