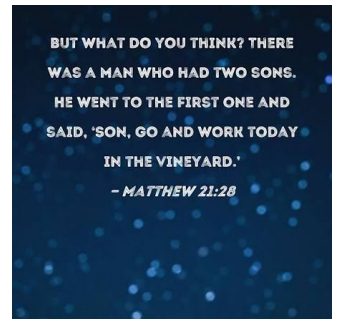


GENEROUS AND JUST

SCHOOL ADMISSIONS – YEAR 6 MOVING TO YEAR 7

If your child is currently in Year 6, it is now time to start thinking about which secondary school you would like them to attend from September 2027. Suffolk County Council will publish all the information you need to help you make your decision, including details of the application process and available schools, from 12 September 2026.

The deadline for submitting your application is Saturday 31 October 2026. It is important to apply by this date, as late applications may reduce your chances of being offered a place at your preferred school. Please make sure you familiarise yourself with the application process and key deadlines and submit your application on time. CYCLE TO SCHOOL WEEK - 5-9 OCTOBER

Next week is Cycle to School Week, and we are delighted to be taking part in the East Suffolk Cycle to School Week Challenge. We know that many of our children already cycle or scoot to school, which is fantastic. The challenge is a great opportunity to celebrate this and encourage even more children to enjoy being active on their journeys to and from school. Walking and wheeling count too!

Throughout the week, children will be able to record the time they spend cycling, scooting, walking or wheeling. Every 15 minutes of activity earns a square on the challenge poster, with classes and groups working together to see how many minutes of active travel they can clock up. We will be talking to the children about the challenge in school this week so that everyone knows how they can get involved.
