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

Next week I will be sending home a letter formally opening the consultation process on plans to establish nursery provision here at St. Edmund's. The nursery will take up to 13 children at a time with an offer that sees parents and carers able to access nursery care for children aged 3 - 4 years old for half day sessions or full day sessions.

We have been in dialogue with Suffolk County Council who have agreed that there is a need for nursery provision in our area. Therefore, when this letter is circulated, it is important that we gain as many responses to the consultation as possible to reinforce the demand they have identified. It is open to any member of the public to respond and so please can you share the link to the consultation with as many family and friends as you can.

EARTHWAKE NATURE CLUB

After half-term, an Earthwake Nature Club will be starting here at St. Edmund's. The club will run every Monday from 3:15pm – 4:30pm for Years 1-6 starting on Monday 3rd November with the last session on Monday 8th December. There will be art, crafts and snacks as well as torch lit nature adventure and games at Castle Hills. During the sessions, the children will be outdoors so please make sure your child brings warm clothes and wellies, where possible. The cost for the 6 sessions will be £30 and sessions can be booked through WisePay or by speaking to our office staff. The maximum number of children who can attend is 20.
