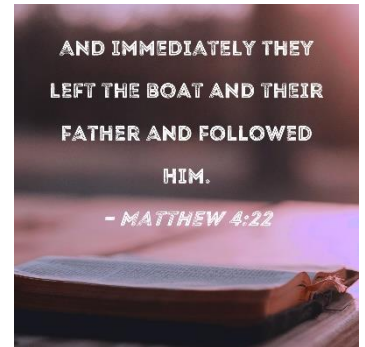

THANK YOU FOR SUPPORTING TT ROCKSTARS DAY

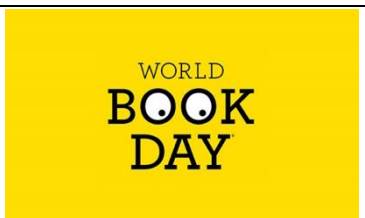
