UPCOMING PHONICS AND MULTIPLICATION CHECKS

Over the coming weeks, our Year 2 children will complete their Phonics Screening Check, while our Year 4 children will take part in the Multiplication Tables Check. These are national assessments that help schools understand how children are progressing in these important areas of learning.

As always, we want to reassure families that there is no pressure placed on the children by school. We encourage them simply to try their best and approach the checks with confidence and positivity. The children have been working hard throughout the year and staff will continue to support and encourage them.

We would also like to take this opportunity to remind parents across all year groups of the importance of continuing to hear your child read regularly at home and encouraging them to access Numbots and TTRockstars. Just a few minutes of regular practice can make a huge difference to children's confidence and progress in reading and maths.

SCHOOL DINNER BOOKINGS

We have noticed that an increasing number of school dinners are not being booked in advance through the system. This creates a significant amount of additional administration for the school office and makes it more difficult for the kitchen to plan meals accurately.

After the half-term break, if meals are not booked by 8:30am on the day, children will automatically receive a chef's choice option, which will be selected from the meals we have additional portions of available that day.
