Counties of East Anglia



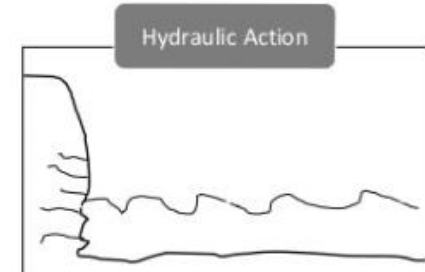
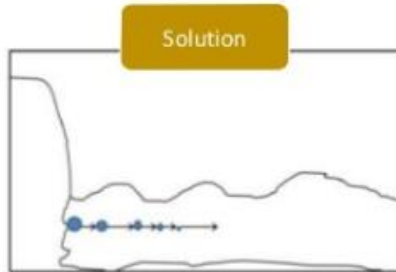
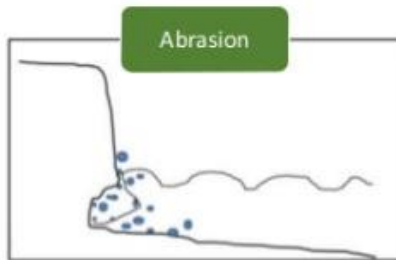
Location of Hemsby



Key Vocabulary

East Anglia	An area of East England, south of the Wash, consisting of Norfolk and Suffolk, and parts of Essex and Cambridgeshire.
Hemsby	A village and seaside resort in the county of Norfolk. It is situated 8 miles (13km) north of Great Yarmouth.
coastline	The land along a coast.
erosion	A process that removes soil, rock, or dissolved material from one location and transports it to another, where it is deposited.
tourism	The organisation and operation of holidays and visits to places of interest.
sea defences	Ways of protecting land from being flooded and worn away by the sea.
preservation	The act of keeping something as it is.
agriculture	The practice of cultivating the soil, producing crops and raising livestock.
industry	People and activities involved in one type of business that produce goods or offers services.
climate	The weather conditions in an area in general, or over a longer period of time.
